What it's like to work with us

The Role

This role will collaborate with stakeholders inside and outside of the firm and be an independent contributor to various projects. We are looking for someone dynamic and collaborative who is eager to support and learn from our existing senior team members.

Responsibilities:

Location: Remote, while Catalyst is headquartered in Berkeley, CA, the team is fully decentralized.

Hours: expected engagement varies depending on needs of the firm. During the academic year, we are looking for a commitment of 10 to 20 hours per week, with the possibility to increase up to 40 hours per week during vacation periods depending on the firm's needs. We can be accommodating (to an extent) regarding candidate availability over the course of a semester.

Term: this is envisioned as a short term role during the 2023/24 academic year. Depending on client mandates, there may be an opportunity for extension post-graduation.
